John 11:43-44 (NRSV)

⁴³When he had said this, he cried with a loud voice, <u>"Lazarus, come out!"</u> ⁴The dead man came out, his hands and feet bound with strips of cloth, and his face wrapped in a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Unbind him, and let him go."

When Jesus raised His friend Lazarus from the dead, we notice that there are two parts to this miracle. Jesus brought Lazarus from **death to life** and Jesus required that Lazarus' community **"unbind"** him.

We have been looking at the freedom that the Spiritual Disciplines give us to see God more intimately every day. Most recently, we have been looking at the opportunities of growth that are ours through the Spiritual Discipline of Fasting. We've been encouraged to "Fast for a Spiritual breakthrough."
